

Grissom Air Reserve Base Joint Land Use Study Implementation
Voluntary Real Estate Disclosure

If you are contemplating leasing, renting, buying, or selling a tract of land in the Grissom Air Reserve Base (ARB) Joint Land Use Study (JLUS) Study Area, you should be aware the area depicted on the map on the following page may be subject to military training impacts, including impacts related to noise, vibration, odors, flight safety hazards, and other impacts related to operations associated with Grissom ARB.

Grissom ARB has been an active military facility since 1942 and a joint use military-civilian airport since 2008. New occupants or residents moving to locations near its borders should realize they could experience the above conditions resulting from living near a busy military installation.
